Foundation Making Waves in Angwa Mada

Founded in 1990, the Tunde Dada Foundation has been consistently dedicated to helping people in need from organizing clothing drives, assisting pastors in building churches, visiting and donating to motherless babies homes, feeding the hungry, providing free medicine and consultation, as well as providing spiritual enrichment.

Over this past year, some of the Foundation's accomplishments include assisting pastors in their ministry through buying land and constructing their churches, functioning out of a number of outreach locations within Abuja FCT, and buying tools for beneficiaries who have learnt a trade and want to get back on their feet by making a living.

We currently feed and pro-

vide free medication to approximately 200+ people every Sunday. Please note that we have changed our outreaches from meeting bi-weekly to meeting weekly given our growing number of locations.

Thanks to your donations, the clothing drive in Angwa Mada was an enormous success. We had a truck filled with women and children's clothes and within an hour or two, practically every single item was distributed to people in need and this surprised even us! The people were very excited and grateful to receive these clothes and shoes and we hope to continue to be a blessing to them by providing them with these items regularly.



With this said, the clothing drive is an ongoing event and we are still collecting donations of new and used clothes, shoes, and even bags. If you are donating a large volume of items, the TD Foundation will come and pick them up. So give us a call today! In addition, we are appealing specially to men to donate their old clothes. For every old shirt that you no longer want, there are about 10 men who desperately need it. Lets make their day.

Introducing “Allah Ina Na,” Child of The TD Foundation

This is the story of *Allah Ina Na* (“God is Here”), a beautiful little boy with very humble beginnings. Although he is just six months old, his big bright eyes tell a tale of someone much older. The TD Foundation first met little *Allah Ina Na* when he was just a few days old. His mother died while giving birth. She bled to death. And his father— well no one really knows where exactly his father is. From the day of his birth, *Allah Ina Na* has been raised by his grandmother and the TD Foundation has been buying him baby formula ever since. Interestingly enough, before receiving encouragement, *Allah Ina Na*’s grand-

mother had intended to literally give the TD Foundation the child because she did not know how she would



care for him. During the clothing drive in Angwa Mada on October 25th, we were able to supply our baby with some clothes and a few “onesies.” Clothes that you donated; and we truly appreciate this.

to medical facilities. The TDF plans to establish outreach centers in each state of

the federation where we will be able to minister spiritually, physically, financially, and in all other areas to the poor. In order

to reach this goal, we need partners and sponsors that will help build our capacities and resources.

In addition, we require assistance in our medical outreaches. During our activities

in Wuse Zone 3, many of the people that our doctors have seen have medical cases that cannot be handled during the outreach.

There are several of them that require eye surgery, there are some that still carry bullet pellets in their bodies, and so many that require other types of rehabilitation and treatment.
